## Orang Asli families in Bentong, Raub receive food aid



**KUALA LUMPUR**: A total of 1,132 Orang Asli families who were affected by the recent flood in Pahang received flood relief aid from Yayasan Azman Hashim (YAH).

The food supply was distributed by Amcorp Properties Berhad chairman Shalina Azman with staff from Amcorp Perting Mini Hydro Sdn Bhd power plant.

"Each family received rice, cooking oil, canned foods, tea, coffee and dried supplies," Shalina said.

Bentong district's Orang Asli Welfare Department officer Zali Rami said many Orang Asli families were affected by the recent flood which damaged roads and destroyed farms and livestock.
