The medical equipment worth RM52,200 consist of 1 unit of Hemo Dialysis Machine 4008S Next Generation and 1 unit of Liquid Nitrogen Storage Dewar 20L. These medical equipment are crucial for various purposes such as delivering high quality hemodialysis treatment and storing liquid nitrogen for medical or laboratory use.
