## Yayasan Azman Hashim Sponsors RM200k Towards MITAA's 60th Merdeka Anniversary Celebration

The Honourable Society of the Inner Temple is one of the four Inns of Court (professional association for barristers and judges) in London. The Inn is a professional body that provides legal training, selection and regulations for members. In order to be called to Bar and practise as a barrister in England and Wales, an individual must belong to one of these Inns. MITAA is the Malaysian Alumni Association of the Honourable Society of the Inner Temple, United Kingdom.

MITAA, a non-profit organization, was formed in 2006. The late DYMM Almarhum Tuanku Abdul Rahman, Malaysia's first King along with Malaysia's first Prime Minister, the late Tunku Abdul Rahman were also barristers and members of the MITAA.

The documentary "Of Wig and Robe" was produced under the auspices of the Istana Besar Seri Menanti, Negeri Sembilan and Inner Temple, London. It featured the role of DYMM Almarhum Tuanku Abdul Rahman as the first King of the independent Federation of Malaya and offered insight on how studying law at Inner Temple had helped prepare him for this important role as the first ruler of a newly independent nation. A sneak peak of the

documentary was shown at the MITAA Annual Dinner in August 2017 and MITAA intends to broadcast the documentary at both the domestic and international levels.
