Following the recent spike in Covid-19 cases in Sandakan district, HDOK Management has opened two temporary Covid-19 (stable) treatment centres in Sandakan Sports Complex and Batu Putih PPR.

In response to HDOK's request for assistance, YAH and Amprop, each delivered medical supplies to HDOK. The medical supplies donated by YAH amounting to RM21,800 consists oxygen flowmeter with humidifier bottle, BactiTrap pipeline filter, pin index regulators and N95 masks. The items donated by Amprop are face shields, stainless steel urinals, disposable aprons and N95 masks worth RM20,212.

HDOK is the third largest government hospital located around 3.2 kilometre from the town centre of Sandakan. The 400-bed hospital constructed over a 42.93 acres land, provides specialist services for outpatient and inpatient in the district. The hospital is named after the British Princess Marina, Duchess of Kent.
