PUTRAJAYA: RCE Capital Berhad ("RCE") donated some medical equipment to Hospital Putrajaya ("HPJ"). This initiative is part of our corporate social responsibility program, aimed at supporting HPJ in enhancing the quality of its healthcare services.

The medical equipment worth RM51,300 consist of 1 unit of GSI-Pello Diagnostic Audiometer and 1 unit of Nihon Kohden Cardiolife Automated External Defibrillator 3100. These medical equipment are crucial for various purposes such as evaluating hearing ability and supporting cardiac emergency response.

HPJ was founded in 1998 and began operations in stages on 1 November 2000. It is equipped with Total Hospital Information System and 592 inpatient beds.

Over the years, RCE has been focusing on promoting health awareness through various medical equipment donations. To-date, RCE donated close to RM730,000 worth of medical equipment to 6 government hospitals: Hospital Tengku Ampuan Rahimah, Hospital Sungai Buloh, Hospital Ampang, Hospital Kuala Lumpur, HPJ, and Hospital Umum Sarawak. RCE is hopeful that these contributions could help alleviate the burden of our healthcare system on heavy load of medical cases and provide sufficient medical treatment to the patients.
