SELAYANG: RCE Capital Berhad (“RCE”) donated medical equipment to Hospital Selayang (“HS”). This initiative is part of our corporate social responsibility program, aimed at supporting HS in enhancing the quality of its healthcare services.

The medical equipment worth RM50,000 consist of 1 unit of Valleylab FX8 energy platform. This medical equipment is crucial for various purposes such as supporting electrosurgery and tissue-fusion technologies, ensuring optimal cutting and coagulation while minimising tissue damage.

HS is located at Selayang in the Gombak District, Selangor. It provides secondary and selected national tertiary care services, equipped with 960 inpatient beds and 20 clinical disciplines.

Over the years, RCE has been focusing on promoting health awareness through various medical equipment donations. To-date, RCE donated close to RM830,000 worth of medical equipment to 8 government hospitals: Hospital Tengku Ampuan Rahimah, Hospital Sungai Buloh, Hospital Ampang, Hospital Kuala Lumpur, Hospital Putrajaya, Hospital Umum Sarawak, Hospital Sultan Idris Shah Serdang, and HS. RCE is hopeful that these contributions could help alleviate the burden of our healthcare system on heavy load of medical cases and provide sufficient medical treatment to the patients.
