RCE Capital Berhad donates medical equipment worth RM50,000 to Hospital Ampang

AMPANG: RCE Capital Berhad ("RCE") donated medical equipment to Hospital Ampang ("HA"). This initiative is part of our corporate social responsibility program, aimed at supporting HA in enhancing the quality of its healthcare services.

The medical equipment worth RM50,000 consist of 2 units of Defibrillator Monitor "Biphasic" Defibrillator with AED and Pacing. These medical equipment are crucial to support cardiac emergency response.

HA is a government hospital in Selangor established since 2006, which provides medical specialist services, clinical and non-clinical healthcare support services. The hospital has 17 wards with a capacity of 701 beds. HA is also one of the earliest hospitals to use the Total Hospital Information System.

Over the years, RCE has been focusing on promoting health awareness through various medical equipment donations. To-date, RCE donated close to RM880,000 worth of medical equipment to 8 government hospitals: Hospital Tengku Ampuan Rahimah, Hospital Sungai Buloh, HA, Hospital Kuala Lumpur, Hospital Putrajaya, Hospital Umum Sarawak, Hospital Sultan Idris Shah Serdang, and Hospital Selayang. RCE is hopeful that these contributions could help alleviate the burden of our healthcare system on heavy load of medical cases and provide sufficient medical treatment to the patients.
